## Removal of the Facade of 130 Liberty Street

**Deconstruction of 130 Liberty** As part of the approved demolition plan for 130 Liberty Street, will be closely monitored the removal of the façade on the top floor, the 39<sup>th</sup> floor, has begun.

**Deconstruction of 130 Liberty** With approvals from the NYC Department of Buildings and will be closely monitored Federal, State and City Environmental Regulators, the process will consist of the cleaning of residue from the exterior building and removal of the exterior facia which consists of glass and metal (column covers and windows) on 39<sup>th</sup>, 38<sup>th</sup>, 37<sup>th</sup>, 36<sup>th</sup> and 35<sup>th</sup> floors. This material will be cut into lengths, wrapped in plastic and moved off the site.

The removal of the façade is a prelude to the structural deconstruction of the 130 Liberty Street building which involves the removal of interior structural steel and concrete on each floor. As the exterior work progresses, the approved environmental abatement/decontamination process will also continue.
